Integrated usual care of chronic pressure injury wounds in patient with palliative care : case study

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Abstract

Palliative care is a philosophy and a system for deciding care and can be used alone or integrated with usual chronic disease care. Palliative care encompasses end-of-life care. There are aims to enhance quality of life, optimize function and manage symptoms including early in the course of chronic diseases. The purposes of this study are to outline palliative care and discuss show it can be integrated with usual care of chronic pressure injury wounds. People with chronic disease who has pressure injury of palliative care patients with poor prognosis can die suddenly, although the life course is usually long with periods of stable and unstable disease. Palliative care can be integrated with usual pressure injury wounds care associated with improved function, comfortable, better quality of life and greater patient and family satisfaction.
